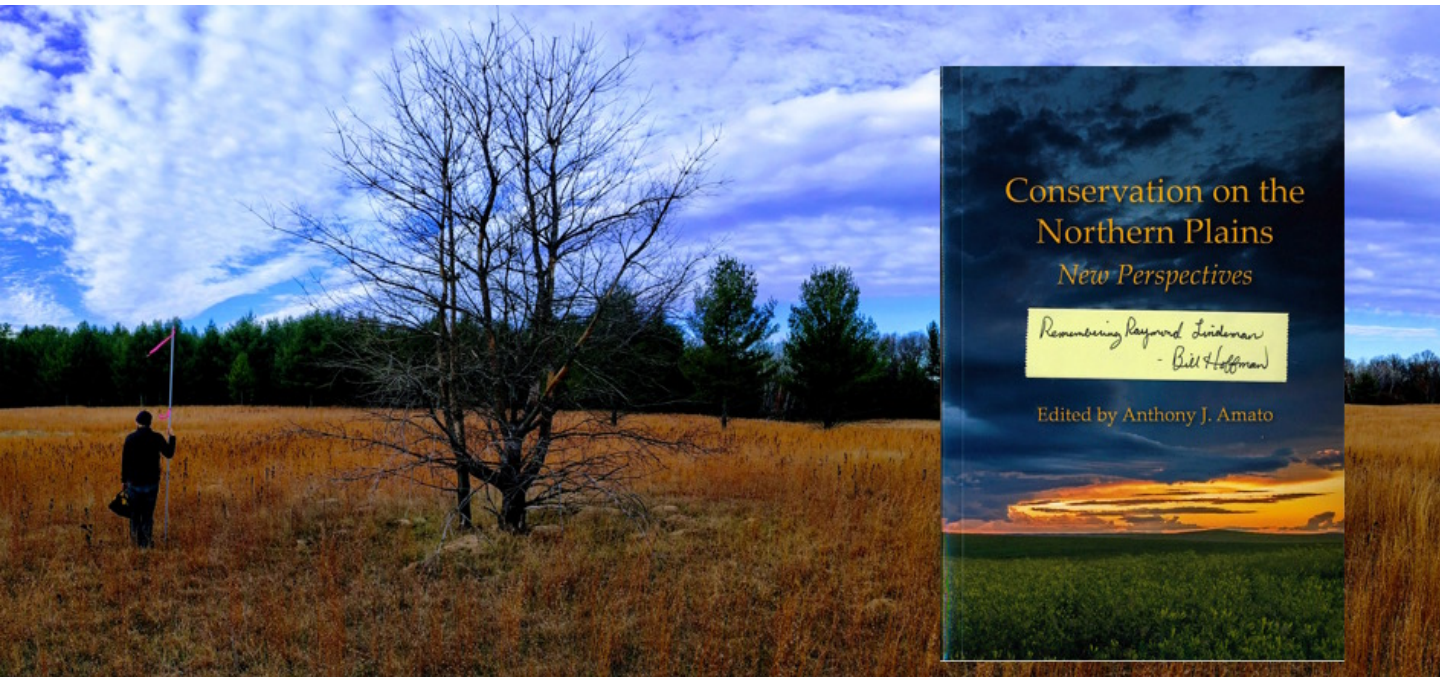
Our mission is to:
